# LIFETIME MEMBER

## ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

Life Membership status in USEA may be granted to current or former members of USEA. USEA employees are not eligible for this award.

Recipients of this honor should truly reflect the highest degree of commitment to the purposes and ideals of this Association, and should have served on their local boards and/or the USEA State Executive Board for a total of at least ten (10) years.

## PRIVILEGES

Privileges shall be limited to:

A voice at any meeting of USEA. Life Members who are all current USEA Board Members are still entitled to vote.

Exemption from paying any dues to USEA effective the month Life Membership is awarded for a period of three years.

## SELECTION PROCESS

### Life Membership Award Committee

The USEA President shall appoint, each year, a committee of three (3) members, one (1) of whom shall be a current Life Member if possible, to review and recommend any nominations that it may receive.

All nominations shall be screened to maintain the highest standards for this award. The committee may recommend nominees for consideration and a vote at a Board Meeting no less than thirty (30) days before Delegate Conference by a two-thirds majority vote.

## Nominations

Nominations may come from any USEA chapter on an approved nomination form with the signature of the chapter president. The chapter must also get a USEA Executive Board Member to sign the nomination form.

Nominations should spell out specifically the exemplary qualities the member has demonstrated in order to be considered as a candidate for Life Membership.

## Presentation

Life Membership and privileges may only be awarded and become effective at Delegate Conference. The recipient shall be presented with a certificate attesting to his/her Life Membership.

## NUMBER OF LIFE MEMBERSHIPS

The USEA Board and Delegates are not required to grant Life Membership in any one year, but are limited to granting one Life Membership in any one year.
